

**PAN-CANADIAN ASSESSMENT PROGRAM
PCAP SCIENCE, MATHEMATICS, AND READING ASSESSMENT (2013)**

CALL FOR SCORERS

Scoring Session, Moncton, New Brunswick, July 8–19, 2013

The Pan-Canadian Assessment Program (PCAP) is a cyclical program of assessments of student achievement in science, mathematics, and reading conducted by the Council of Ministers of Education, Canada. The assessment will be administered to approximately 40,000 students from over 1,500 schools across Canada.

The assessment covers three domains: science, mathematics, and reading. Although each assessment has questions on all three domains, the focus shifts with each assessment. In 2013, the focus will be on science. The assessment will be conducted in April–May 2013 in participating schools.

PCAP 2013 will be scored in Moncton, New Brunswick, between July 8 and 19, 2013. Over 80 experienced teachers from across the country will be involved. The science component will be scored between July 8 and 19, 2013, the mathematics component between July 8 and 12, and the reading component between July 15 and 19. All scorers must be available for the entire duration of their respective scoring session.

Individuals wishing to participate are invited to outline their qualifications and experience, using the Application Form to be completed on-line. All applications will be considered.

Preference will be given to applicants who meet the following criteria:

- have a background in teaching science, mathematics, or language arts (as applicable) at the Grade 8/Secondary Two level;
- be a student teacher, current teacher, substitute teacher, or retired teacher;
- reside in the immediate vicinity of Moncton.

Bilingualism is considered an asset.

The daily fee is \$200 per day (includes 4 per cent vacation pay), plus \$18 per workday for incidental expenses. Lunch will be provided. No other expenses, such as transportation or accommodation, will be covered. **The application deadline is May 17, 2013**, after which date all candidates will be notified of the status of their application.
